

The fast, addictive game of opposing forces. Game for 2 players, age 8+.

Content:


- 1 wooden game board.
- 10 light wooden balls.
- 10 dark wooden balls.

Objective:

• To be the first player to line up 4 balls of your chosen color.


Game Preparation:


- Place 18 balls around the perimeter of the playing board, with alternating colors (see picture).
- Position the remaining balls as shown.
- Each player choses a color.
- Players decide who goes first.





Game Play:

- The first player selects one of his own balls and an adjoining ball of his opponent.
- A player may not move a ball individually or with another ball of their own color.
- The two balls are moved as a single unit, one space horizontally, vertically or diagonally, in which both balls can move freely.









An alternate move is to switch the places of the two adjoining balls.





A player may not make a move which reverses the last move made.

Winning:

The first player to line up four balls in a row wins.

Don't let the simple rules of Paradox fool you into thinking it's a simple game. The strategy of the game will go as far as your wits can take it.
