A game for two players

## Content:

- 1 board
- 5 light-toned wooden blocks
- 5 dark-toned wooden blocks
- 2 balls


## Aim of the Game:

To have your ball reach the opposite end of the board.

## Preparations:

Set up the board as shown (Fig. 1) and decide who will play first.


## Game Play:

In turn, each player may do one of two moves:

1. Move a wooden block to an empty square like Knights in the game of Chess; two squares up and one over to either side, in any direction (Fig. 2), OR
2. Pass your ball in an unobstructed line, in any direction, and as many times as you like on a given turn, so long as your ball lands on each wooden block no more than once (Fig. 3).

## Please Note:

- A BLOCK WITH A BALL ON IT MAY NEVER BE MOVED.
- A WOODEN BLOCK CAN PASS OVER AN OPPONENT'S BLOCK AND/OR BALL.
- A BALL CANNOT PASS OVER AN OPPONENT'S BLOCK AND/OR BALL.


## Winning:

To be the first player to have your ball reach the opposite end of the board. (Fig. 3)
